Re: Proposed Landfill at Tooman/Nevitt, North County Dublin.

Dear Madam,

I refer to the above-mentioned proposed development. As the Board has received objections to the confirmation of a compulsory purchase order which relates to this proposed development it is required under section 218 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 to hold an **oral hearing**.

In this regard Mr Des Johnson has been instructed by the Board to hold an oral hearing into the objections. The inspector at this hearing is also entitled to hear evidence in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development and the likely consequences for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development and to report to the Board thereon.

The arrangements for the opening of the oral hearing are as follows:-

Time: 11.00am

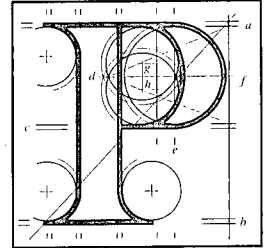
Place: The Anna Livia Suite, The Gresham Hotel, 23 Upper O'Connell Street, Dublin 1.

Please note that it is the practice of the Board to conduct such hearings without undue formality and, in particular, you should note that it is not proposed to take evidence on oath or to prove documentation in relation to the compulsory purchase order procedure.

Where possible written statements of evidence to be given should be submitted and it will assist the conduct of the hearing if copies of these and any related drawings are made available for circulation.

A total of 27 objections in respect of the compulsory purchase order and a total of 135 submissions in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development and the likely consequences for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development have been received and these will be available for inspection by appointment at the offices of Fingal County Council, and An Bord Pleanála prior to the hearing.



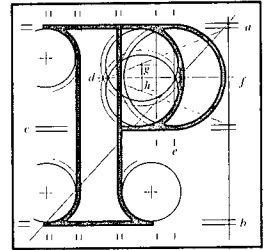
