Dear Stuart,

With regard to the above referenced EPA licence application 205-1, the Applicant, Greyhound Recycling & Recovery Limited has received planning permission for development of an additional waste transfer building on the Crag Avenue site.

A copy of the planning permission for the additional waste transfer building (Register Ref: SD06A/0404) is attached. This additional waste transfer will not alter the quantity and nature of waste which is permitted to be accepted on the site under the existing planning permission.

The construction of the additional waste transfer building will not result in a change in the nature or quantity of waste, or the waste processing activities, from that for which a waste licence has been applied. The nature and type of waste processing to be undertaken in the additional building will be identical to that proposed for the existing waste transfer building.

An original and two copies of the revised site layout plan (Drwg 121), and the proposed ground floor plan (Drwg 122) and elevation plan (Drwg 123) for the additional waste transfer building are attached. Three copies of the drawings are also enclosed on Cd-ROM.


