In accordance with Article 36 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a waste licence to Brownfield Restoration Ireland Ltd, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at, Whitestown Lower, Co Wicklow. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

The licence does not permit the mixed waste landfill and restricts the range of activities to only those associated with the remediation of the historically deposited waste including the deposition of any recovered inert waste in excavated areas.

This decision was made following consideration of the objections and technical committee report to the Agency's proposed decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 and related Regulations. The objections, technical committee report and associated documents are available for inspection or purchase at the Agency's headquarters, on our website at www.epa.ie/Licensing and at the offices of Wicklow County Council in accordance with the Regulations.

Also enclosed is a copy of a <u>draft</u> Guidance Note on Environmental Management Systems and Reporting to the Agency. Conditions of the waste licence for the above facility require that the Agency is notified of specified matters and that reports and other materials are forwarded at defined intervals. The draft Guidance Note is intended to assist you in the production of this information. It is the Agency's intention to complete a review of this document in due course.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0204-01, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and three copies of all items in the correspondence.

The Agency recommends that you meet with Damien Masterson, Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford (053-9160600), to discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
