The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 6 April 2006; objection from the applicant; 6 third party objections; 6 third party submissions on the objections; report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Licensing and Guidance. A copy of the licence application was tabled.

It was noted that the Directors, in their consideration of the application and all other documentation associated with the application, decided that the Proposed Decision should restrict activities at the facility to those associated with remediation and restoration of the site, to the exclusion of those associated with additional commercial waste disposal and or treatment.
