Dear Dr. McNamara,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Kyletalesha & Kyleclonhobert, Portlaoise, Co. Laois. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

A. Non- Technical Summary

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary reflecting the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

Any changes to the non-technical summary shall include, but not be limited to, reference to the European Waste Catalogue Codes as presented by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC.

D. Infrastructure & Operation

Provide a revised drawing of the existing facility to include the existing weighbridge area and the constructed storage area located to the northwest of the site. Any further

structural changes to the existing facility since the grant of Licence Register Number W0194-01 shall also be included in the drawing.

I.2 Surface Waters

Provide a drawing outlining the site service in place on the existing waste transfer site including surface water, leachate handling and domestic wastewater infrastructure.

In addition provide detailed technical information on the type of oil interceptors and attenuation infrastructure currently employed and/or proposed for the extended facility.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of one signed original plus two copies in hardcopy format within 4 weeks of the date of this notice. In addition submit two copies in electronic searchable format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. The e-file should be saved as a 'pdf' file, read only status.

Please note that the application's register number is W0194-02.
