## TRANSFER OF A WASTE LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 47(5) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005

Waste Licence Register No: 195-1

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers waste licence register number 195-1 from McGill Environmental Systems (Ireland) Ltd, Ballinvoher, Castletownroche, Co Cork, to Padraic Thornton Waste Disposal Ltd, Thorntons Recycling, Unit S3B, Parkwest Business Park, Dublin 12. Waste Licence Register No 195-1 licenses the carrying on of the waste activities set out below at a Proposed Compost Facility at Ballynalurgan, Kilmainhamwood, Kells, Co Meath subject to twelve Conditions, as set out in the waste licence.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Third Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005

Class 6	Biological treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 10 of this Schedule:
Class 13.	Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005

Class 2	Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes).
Class 13.	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

In accordance with Section 47(6) of the Acts, Padraic Thornton Waste Disposal Limited is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

## REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 47(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Padraic Thornton Waste Disposal Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like waste licence. Pursuant to Section 47(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Padraic Thornton Waste Disposal Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the report of its inspector.
