## **Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report.

- p.11 A3 In Recommendation, replace the definition of Compost with:

  Compost: The stable, sanitised and humus-like material, rich in organic matter and free from offensive odours, resulting from the composting process of separately collected biodegradable waste, which complies with the quality standards of Schedule E.
- p.12 A3 Note references 5.9.1 and 5.9.2 should read 5.8.1 and 5.8.2 respectively.
- p.13 A3 In Recommendation for 5.8.2, amend end of sentence to read ...and details recorded as per Condition 10.
- p.14 A4 In Recommendation, amend to read...Delete Condition 6.4.1 of the PD. Delete Schedule C.3 Surface Water Discharge Limits (Retain 6.4.2 (renumbered) and 6.5).

The Directors approved the proposed decision to grant a licence, as modified, to McGill Environmental Systems (Ireland) Ltd., Ballynalurgan, Kilmainhamwood, Kells, Co. Meath, Register of Licence No 195-1, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
