Dear Sirs,

As one of the main producers of Fresh Produce in the Fingal area, this company is committed to supplying the market with a consistent supply of the highest quality potatoes, onions and potato products. Country Crest is the major employer in this area employing more than 90 people.

A reliable, uncontaminated supply of water is vital to our business. Our entire business depends on access to unpolluted water - from the washing of the raw material to the cooking of the finished product. Uncontaminated water is also vital to our suppliers to produce the highest quality potato and to our retailers who require guarantees that the produce we supply is free from all contaminants.

Fingal County Council-RPSMCOS -EIS has admitted that 100 ltrs. of poisoned leachate will escape from the landfill on a daily basis, which we believe will be a significant source of contamination for water to the aquifer serving this area.


We would also have major concerns for the health of our staff as we are situated easterly of this proposed site and the prevailing winds are commonly north westerly.

A landfill in this area would lead to a deterioration of the quality of life for all the local community and could be detrimental to our business.

We require a guarantee against pollution of our water supply, the absence of which could be fatal for our business.

Therefore we request the EPA to refuse a Waste Licence to Fingal County Council for this proposed landfill.
