I am to refer to your letter of 18<sup>th</sup> December 2006 notifying the Agency of your withdrawal of the above referenced waste licence application.

The Agency hereby acknowledges that your company has formally withdrawn the above referenced application for a review of a waste licence pursuant to the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. That being the case, it is no longer the function of the Agency to consider any documentation received by it, which relates to the above application

I note your request that the fee paid in respect of this review be retained by the Agency pending submission of the new application and be off-set against the fee required for that application. In this regard I am to advise you that as a significant amount of Agency time and resources has been used in processing this application it would not be appropriate nor does the Agency have the discretion to refund the full fee. I can advise that the Agency would consider any request for a refund of a portion your current fee under Article 45 of the Waste Licensing Regulations S.I. 395 of 2004.

Upon submission of your new review application you are entitled to request a refund of a portion of the fee paid in respect of that application. The Agency would give consideration to any such request received, after the final decision has issued, having had regard to the resources used in processing it.
