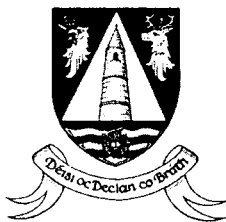

On the international front the Irish men finished their tour to South Africa with a disappointing 3-2 loss to Spain yesterday. Ireland opened the scoring in the seventh minute,

Spain had the upper hand for the remainder of the half, forcing Mark Ruddle to make a number of excellent saves, and they eventually equalised in the 18th minute.

Spain then went two-one ahead only a couple of minutes into the second half, but Ireland clawed their way back into the game and earned a deserved equaliser in the 46th minute through Timmy Cockram.

However Spain scored the winning goal with only 17 seconds left.

Also in South Africa yesterday, Ireland's Senior women lost 2-1 to South Africa in the opening game of their 10-day tour. Debutant Rachel Mulligan scored Ireland's goal.

They play Canada tonight and South Africa again on Wednesday.

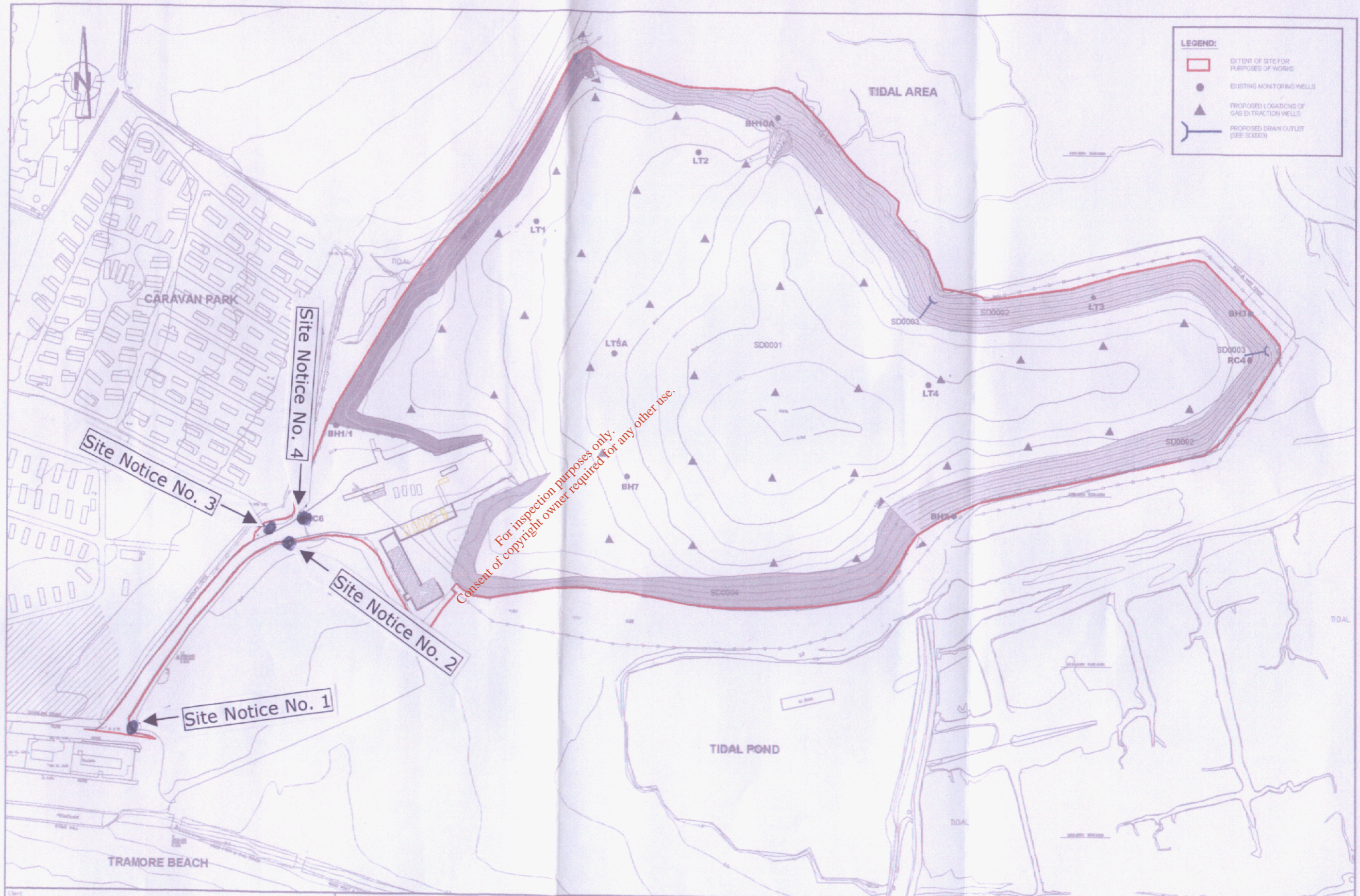
