re: Notice of a decision on a waste licence application, in accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

Dear Mr Finnegan,

In accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a waste licence subject to conditions to Organic Gold (Marketing) Ltd. in respect of a facility at Wilkinstown, Navan, Co. Meath. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0219-01, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and two copies of all items in the correspondence.

Please note that all infrastructure referred to in licence must be established in advance of the commencement of the licensable activities or as required by the conditions of the licence. It is permissible, however, to continue to operate under the conditions of a waste permit to the level permissible under that permit and within the boundaries outlined in said permit.

I would also take this opportunity to draw your attention to Condition 3.1(b) and the requirement for the written approval of the Agency prior to the commencement of the licensable activities.

The Agency recommends that you meet with Mr Eamon Merriman, Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, Richview, Clonskeagh Road, Dublin 14, tel (01) 268 0100 to discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
