The application and associated correspondence, including acknowledgements, notifications and general correspondence are available to view on the Agency Website at <u>www.epa.ie/licensing</u> and also on the public file as they arise, that file may be inspected by any person during office hours at the Agency's headquarters.

Copy extracts from the file will be supplied by the Agency to any person, on request, subject to payment of the reasonable cost of making the copy.

You are advised to refer to the website/public file for information on the progress of the application. The Agency will write to you to inform you of its proposed decision on the review in due course.
