In accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a waste licence to Greyhound Recycling & Recovery Limited, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Greyhound Recycling & Recovery Limited, Crag Avenue , Clondalkin Industrial Estate , Clondalkin, Co Dublin. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

It should be noted that the Agency requires notification, in writing, from the licensee at least one week in advance of the commencement of the licensed waste activities, for compliance with Section 41(6) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005

This decision was made following consideration of the objection and technical committee report to the Agency's proposed decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 and related Regulations. The objection, technical committee report and associated documents are available for inspection or purchase at the Agency's headquarters, on our website at www.epa.ie/Licensing and at the offices of South Dublin County Council in accordance with the Regulations

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0205-01, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and three copies of all items in the correspondence.

You will be contacted in due course by an inspector in the Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, Regional Inspectorate, McComiskey House, Richview, Clonskeagh Road, Dublin 14, who will discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
