**WASTE LICENCE  
Recommended Proposed Decision**

## ***Decision & Reasons for the Decision***

On the basis of the information before it, the Environmental Protection Agency (the Agency) pursuant to its powers under Section 46(8) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2005 proposes to **refuse** to grant a revised licence to **South East Recycling Company Ltd.** to carry on the waste activities that are the subject of waste licence review application Register Number **W0111-03** at **Carrigbawn, Pembrokestown, Co. Wexford.**

In reaching this decision the Environmental Protection Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the applicant, all submissions received from other parties and the report of its inspector.

### ***Reasons for the Proposed Decision***

1. The applicant has not demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Agency, that the expansion in operations applied for in the licence application review will be carried out in accordance with the conditions of a revised licence if granted.
2. The level of non-compliance with the conditions of the current licence is such that there is a real and likely danger that such non-compliance will cause environmental pollution.
3. The applicant has failed to convince the Agency, to the extent necessary to satisfy the provisions of Section 40(4)(d) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996-2005, that any person or persons employed by him to direct or control the carrying on of the expanded activity to which the application relates, has or have the requisite technical knowledge to carry on the proposed expanded activity in accordance with any proposed licence.
4. The Agency is not satisfied, based on the current infrastructure at the facility and non compliance with requirements of the existing licence to provide the necessary infrastructure to carry on the waste activities, that the best available technologies as described in Section 40(4)(c) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996-2005 will be used at the facility.
5. The Agency is not satisfied that the applicant will manage an increased waste input and ensure that the necessary protective measures are taken so that operations at the facility will not cause or lead to environmental pollution.
