
Further to our recent correspondence, please find enclosed for your review, our application for an IPCC licence for our proposed manufacturing activity at Ballymote Business Park, Carrownanty, Ballymote, Co. Sligo. Also enclosed is a cheque for €7,618, the relevant fee for review of our application.

The proposed activity is the manufacture of Malathion as a pharmaceutical substance. Our customer will formulate this substance in a topical head-lice treatment product. The manufacturing operation will be on a laboratory scale, with an annual product volume estimated at 25 kilos.

We intend to carry out further laboratory R&D trials on this process in the coming months. Once we have finalised our manufacturing process, we will advise you of any changes to our manufacturing procedures.

We intend to develop and manufacture additional products on a similar small scale in the future. We will of course seek prior approval from you for the manufacture of any such additional products.
