re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Kyck,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Cappincur Industrial Estate, Daingean Road, Tullamore, Co. Offaly. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 6 and Article 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

The notice published in respect of the application contravenes Article 6(c) of the regulations. The notice as erected or fixed on the facility or premises contravenes Article 7(3)(b) of the regulations. Details in relation to the quantity of wastes involved are to be specified.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

1. Publish an amended newspaper notice in accordance with Article 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. This should be published in the newspaper, which carried the original notice.
2. Replace the existing site notice with an amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.
3. Maintain the notice as amended at a location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations for a period of two months following the making of the specified amendment.
4. An amended written notice should be given to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations including the specified amendments.
5. The above requirements should be carried out within two (2) weeks of the date of this notice.



The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:


1. An original of the newspaper and two copies of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the amended notice has been published.
2. An original and two copies of both a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed and a drawing showing its location on site.
3. An original and two copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.
4. An original and two copies of the amended written notice to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9.

In addition it is noted that an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was not included with the licence review application. Please provide a letter from the Planning Authority confirming that an EIS is not required.

The evidence requested should be submitted within four weeks of the date of this notice, in the form of one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawing must not exceed A3 in size.

Please note that the format of the application's register number has been revised to **W0113-03**.
