

It is important to note that any objection to a proposed decision/request for an oral hearing **must be received by the Agency before the expiration of the appropriate period as specified in the accompanying notification.** An objection/request for an oral hearing must be made **either** by sending the objection or request by prepaid post to the Agency, **or** by leaving the objection or request with an employee of the Agency at the Headquarters of the Agency in Wexford during office hours, i.e. 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Please note that the objection period ends on 6th August 2007. As the offices of the Agency are closed on that day, in accordance with Article 17 (1) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2003, the latest date for receipt of an objection is extended to 7th August 2007.
