Warning On The Dangers Of Flash Flooding

Following on from the very street kerbs and signage, nor-heavy rain, which caused so mally there as a convenience to much havoc with serious and unfortunate loss of life to both young and old in parts of England and Wales, the Chairman of Irish Water Safety Mr. Frank Nolan is concerned that a similar situation could arise in Ireland during the summer.

Irish Water Safety feels that it is timely to give warning and bring to the notice of the public the concern of the Chairman on this matter. As in the United Kingdom, Ireland faces at anytime the possibility of flooding, caused by very heavy and widespread rain resulting from the passage of low pressure over the country.

'We wish to take this oppor-tunity to warn about the risks to the public if such weather conditions where to hit this country, which could lead to flash flooding. It is appreciated

the public, suddenly become dangerous obstacles in flood waters, therefore Irish Water Safety impress on people to avoid tragedy by calling for as-sistance at the FIRST sign of danger. Do not wait until it is too late. In extreme circumstances floodwater can rise one metre in a very short period of time, even in less than five minutes. If you are in your dwelling or office try to move up to a higher floor until help arrives. Remember also that it is in the night time that flash flooding occurs which increases the hazard dramatically. Remember also that electricity and water do not mix and great care must be taken if using electric appliances in flooded or damp conditions especially in a dwelling or other place. The advice of the


