I refer to your application for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control licence, which was received on 14 June 2007

I am to advise in accordance with Article 8(b) of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2004, that the newspaper notice and site notice published and erected in pursuance of Article 5 of said Regulations do not comply with the provisions of Articles 6 & 7 of said Regulations.

1. Please publish a further newspaper notice and erect a further site notice which identify the appropriate class of the activity in accordance with the First Schedule of the EPA Acts, 1992 and 2003 and shall include the following heading "Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Licence". The notices shall be in accordance with Articles 6 & 7 of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2004.
2. In accordance with Article 9 of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2004, you are required to give notice to the Planning Authority in writing under Section 87(1)(a) of the EPA Acts, 1992 and 2003. The notice shall at least contain the information referred to in Article 6 of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2004.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have evidence of the required documents (copy of newspaper advertisement, copy of site notice & copy of notice to Planning Authority) (5 copies) submitted to the Agency without delay.
