Dear Mr Cannon

I refer to your application for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control licence, which was received on 14 June 2007

I am to advise in accordance with Article 11(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2004, that the following information is required in support of the application under Article 10 of the Regulations:

1. It is considered that class 5.16 of the EPA Acts 1992 and 2003 and paragraph 4.5 of the IPPC Directive (96/61/EC) are the most appropriate descriptions of the activity, please complete sections B.3 and B.10;
2. Please clarify the source and possible emissions associated with the air emission point referred to as "muffle furnace exhaust";
3. Provide details of the scrubber system installed on one of the production laboratory fume hood extraction systems. Identify the periods of operation and any controls employed;
4. Clarify the hourly flowrates for emission point E1 (Fumehood 1) and E2 (Fumehood 2) and calculate the predicted concentration and mass emission of TA Luft Class 1, 2 and 3 associated with each emission point;
5. Please complete Table G.1(ii) for each of the materials identified under table G.1(i);
6. Identify, if possible, the contractor who will be used to remove and dispose/recover wastes generated on-site; and
7. Provide information to show that the person is likely to be in a position to meet any financial commitments or liabilities that may have been or will be entered into or incurred in carrying on the activity to which the application relates or in consequence of ceasing to carry out the activity.

In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within **six weeks** of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 2 copies in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should be directed to Elizabeth Leacy, Administration Officer, Office of Licensing & Guidance.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact Mr Patrick Byrne at the number above.
