Soltec intend to run its plant and transport vehicles on biodiesel thus reducing Soltec's carbon emissions.

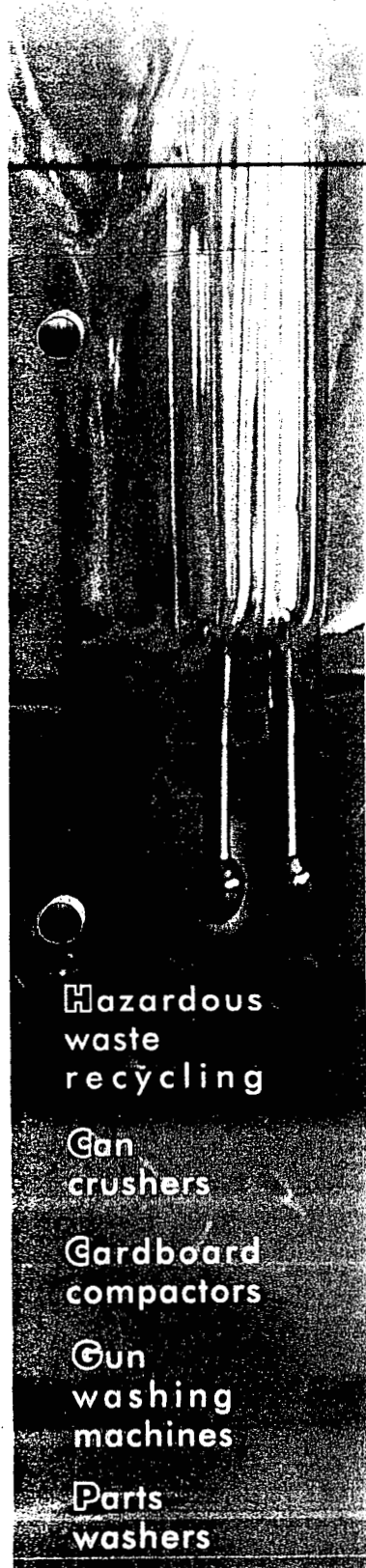
