APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2007 and Articles 5 and 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004), that Dublin City Council (on behalf of the four Dublin Local Authorities: Dublin City Council, Fingal County Council, South Dublin County Council and Dun Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council), having its principal offices at Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8, will apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), P.O. Box 3000, Johnstonstown Castle Estate, Ballymount Road Lower, Dublin 22 (National Grid Reference: E3096566, N2306888).

The Waste Licence Application proposes a total capacity of processing 100,000 tonnes per annum of mixed dry recyclable materials (predominantly "green bin" materials collected from households in the four Dublin Local Authority areas as listed above). The existing Waste Licence W0208-01 will reduce its total capacity by 100,000 tonnes; therefore there will be no overall increase in total waste tonnage arising from the two sites as a result of this application.

Class 12: Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule. Class 13: Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

Class 1: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological processes) [Principal Activity]. Class 2: Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

Class 3: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic material. Class 4: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic material. Class 13: Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

A copy of the application for the Waste Licence and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will, as soon as practicable be available for inspection or purchase, at the EPA Headquarters, Johnstonstown Castle State, County Wexford or Dublin City Council, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8.

ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER N2 COOLFORE, ASHBORNE National Primary Pavement Improvement and Minor Improvement Works Road Traffic Act 2004

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 and in the interests of road safety, the County Manager has made an adjoining site. Dublin City Council is applying for a stand-alone licence for its site in order to operate independently.
