Dear Ms Peters,

I refer to your request for a Technical Amendment to waste licence W0074-02 for Donohill Landfill, which was received by the Agency on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2007. I apologise for the delay in dealing with this case, it seems your letter on arrival at the EPA was directed to the incorrect section.

The following additional information is required in order to properly assess the request for a Technical Amendment:

1. An outline evaluation of the impact that the proposed discharge will have on the stream;
2. Details of abatement proposals for the discharge to the stream, particularly in relation to suspended solids;
3. The most recent quarterly and annual monitoring results/reports for leachate monitoring point SW5, in accordance with *Schedule D.5* of waste licence W0074-02. In addition to the parameters specified in *Schedule D.5*, details of suspended solids content of the leachate concerned should also be submitted;
4. Clarification on the location of "production Zone 2" as referred to in Section 2.6 Recommendations of the report "Surface Waste Management Plan & Procedures" as prepared by Fehilly Timoney & Company.

It should be noted that no further assessment of the request may be carried out until the information requested is submitted. If you have any further queries please do not hesitate to contact me at the number above.
