- 3.17.1 Insert new subcondition (v) to read: and in the case of putrescible waste, into a sealed container.
- 3.17.5 Amend to read: At least one covered and bunded hazardous waste storage unit shall be provided and maintained at the facility. This unit or units shall be constructed and maintained in a manner suitable, and be of size appropriate, for the storage of the different classes of household hazardous waste accepted. The hazardous waste area shall be clearly identified and labelled. Insert new sentence requiring WEEE to be stored as per Agency guidance.

The Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork County Council for their facility at Dunmanway Civic Amenity Site, Kilbarry Road, Dunmanway, County Cork, Register of Licence No W0236-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
