Recommended Decision on an Application for a Waste Licence

Lusk
County Dublin**

The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing & Resource Use that the Agency approve the recommended decision to grant a Waste licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Decision, 108 third party submissions; summary report of the Inspector.

A copy of the licence application was tabled.

Glossary

Under Incident insert new bullet number (vi) to read: *cessation of flare operation*
Amend definition of Residual Waste to read: *Is, in the context of landfill, waste that has been subjected to pre-treatment (including, inter alia, pre-segregation of recyclables and of the biodegradable fraction, mechanical-biological treatment, energy recovery) to extract, to the maximum practical and available extent having regard to BAT, the recyclable/reusable components and energy benefit, in order to contribute to the objectives of the Landfill Directive as set out in Article 1 of the Directive.*

Condition

- 1.5.2(ii) Amend to read: Operations shall be carried out between the hours of 0730 to 1830 *daily* and 0800 to 1630 on Public Holidays.
- 3.5.2 Amend 1st sentence to read: All in-stream and shall be *as approved by the ERFB prior to implementation.*
- 3.5.3 Amend to read: A leave-strip of the section of watercourse *that is to be removed).*
- 5.8 Amend to read: Non-trade effluent wastewater *that occur on site shall not be discharged Water Services Authority.*
- 5.9 Amend to read: No discharge or emission to sewer shall take place *that gives rise liberation of by-products that may be of environmental significance.*
- 6.1.2 Insert new bullet number (v) to read: *Flare operation*

- 6.6.5(ii) Amend to read: Acceptance and management of pre-treated biological sludges;
- 6.9 Amend heading to read: *Ash Storage*
- 6.9.1 Amend to read: Amend to read: Prior to acceptance of waste-to-energy plant bottom ash *for storage* dust nuisance. The licensee *shall* also submit Waste Classification Tool.
- 6.12.2 Amend to read: A report on the ecological monitoring required above shall be submitted to the Agency *and to the Heritage Section of the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government* each year as part of the Annual Environmental Report.
- 8.1.1 Amend to read: *Only residual wastes shall be accepted for disposal at the landfill facility. This requirement may, subject to the agreement of the Agency, not apply to:*
- (i) *inert wastes for which treatment is not technically feasible*
 - (ii) *other waste for which such treatment does not contribute to the objectives of the Landfill Directive as set out in Article 1 of the Directive by reducing the quantity of the waste or the hazards to human health or the environment.*
- 8.1.2 Amend to read: *Prior to the acceptance of residual waste at the facility the licensee shall submit a proposal, for the agreement of the Agency, detailing the proposed pre-treatment method or combination of methods for all waste types. The proposed pre-treatment shall be prioritised as follows;*
- (i) *source segregation to include, in particular, segregation of recyclables and separate segregation of the biodegradable organic fractions (3 bin system or equivalent),*
 - (ii) *Mechanical Biological Treatment (MBT),*
 - (iii) *energy recovery.*
- 8.14 Amend to read: *Waste shall be accepted at the facility only from Local Authority or as may be amended.*

The Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Fingal County Council for their facility at Nevitt, Lusk, County Dublin, Register of Licence No W0231-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
