APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE LICENCE

RILTA Environmental Ltd., 151 Thomas Street, Dublin 8 will apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford, for a review of the conditions of Waste Licence 192-1 for the Integrated Waste Management Facility located at Block 402, Greenogue Business Park, Greenogue, Rathcoole, County Dublin (Grid Reference E301579 N228431). It is proposed that the waste licence is reviewed to increase annual tonnage at the site to 111,000 tonnes per annum, review air emission thresholds, review Eff2 parameter thresholds and to rename the licence to reflect the name change at the facility. The classes of activity concerned are specified in the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as follows:-

THE PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY TO BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SITE IS: Class 13 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act (1996)

"Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced." The facility is also govered under the following classes of activity:

Third Schedule:

Class 7, Class 11, Class 12, Class 13

Fourth Schedule:

Class 2, Class 3, Class 4, Class 5, Class 6, Class 8, Class 13.

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) has been submitted with this application to the EPA. The application for the review of the waste licence, the accompanying Environmental Impact Statement and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the Application, will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase, at the EPA Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford.
