- 1/ Horticultural industry in North county Dublin.
- 2/ Cleanest food producing aquifer in Ireland
- 3/ There are over 100 wells down gradient from this proposed landfill some used for ~~very~~ irrigation & washing of vegetables & potatoes.
- 4/ The public water supply at Bog of the King is of regional importance.
- 5/ RPS have admitted at least 36500 litres of leachate will leak out per year, so how can anyone give a 100 per cent assurance that some of this leachate will not leak in to this very important aquifer.

EPA is supposed to protect the environment & water supplies not to destroy & contaminate by granting a license for a landfill on a aquifer.
