Review of a Waste Licence re: Murphy Environmental (trading division of Murphy Concrete (Manufacturing) Ltd.) at Hollywood Great, Nags Head, The Naul, Co Dublin.

Dear Ms Boothman

I am to refer to your letter of 18/10/2007, received on 19/10/2007, in relation to the review of a waste licence reference number W0129-02, by Murphy Concrete Manufacturing Ltd., in respect of a facility at Murphy Environmental (trading division of Murphy Concrete (Manufacturing) Ltd.), Hollywood Great, Nags Head, The Naul, Co Dublin.

I am to advise that your letter will be treated as a submission and will be taken into account when determining the review, in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005, and Article 15 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, which provides as follows:

Extract from the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Submissions to the Agency regarding applications.

15. For the purpose of Section 40(2)(b) of the Act, a person may make a written submission to the Agency in relation to -

(i) an application, and

such plans, documents and other information and particulars, including an environmental impact statement, as are submitted by the applicant in accordance with Articles 12, 13, 14 and 16, and the Agency shall not give notice of a proposed decision under Section 42(2) of the Act before the expiry of a period of one month following the date of a relevant —

(a) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 14(2)(a), or

(b) notice in accordance with Article 16(2)(a), or

(c) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 16(4), whichever such date is the later.

The application and associated correspondence, including acknowledgements, notifications and general correspondence are available to view on the Agency Website at www.epa.ie and also on the public file as they arise, that file may be inspected by any person during office hours at the Agency's headquarters.

Copy extracts from the file will be supplied by the Agency to any person, on request, subject to payment of the reasonable cost of making the copy.

You are advised to refer to the website/public file for information on the progress of the application. The Agency will write to you to inform you of its proposed decision on the review in due course.
