Dear Sir/Madam

I am to acknowledge receipt of your correspondence to the Agency dated 23 October 2007 received on 24 October 2007, in relation to the above referenced waste licence application.

In response to your request, I am to advise that the "appropriate period" for lodging an objection is set out in the *Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2007, see Section 42* and is the period of 28 days beginning on the day on which notification of a proposed decision issues from the Agency.

The "appropriate period" for the lodging of a submission on an objection is set out in the *Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 S.I. No. 395 of 2004* and is the period of one month beginning on the day on which the circulation of objections issued from the Agency.

In respect of the above-mentioned application the objection period ended on 17 October 2007 and the submission on objection period ends on 21 November 2007. As these are the statutory periods, the Agency has no discretion to accept objections or submissions on objections outside these periods.
