re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Tonge,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Tonge Industries Limited, Unit 7, First Avenue, Cookstown Industrial Estate, Tallaght, Dublin 24. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Indicate whether the applicant or other relevant person has been convicted under the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2003, the EPA Acts 1992 and 200, the Local Government (Water Pollution) Acts 1977 and 1990 or the Air Pollution Act 1987.
2. Provide information to demonstrate that energy will be used efficiently at the facility.
3. Provide details of the location of a monitoring point for surface water run-off from the facility and proposals for sampling and monitoring of the surface water run-off.
4. Describe the proposed measures for the closure of the facility.
5. Provide a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.


ARTICLE 9 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Agency notes that the notice submitted to the Planning Authority in accordance with Article 9(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations does not comply with the requirements of Article 9(2) insofar as it does not contain all the information specified in Article 6. You are required to re-submit a notice to the planning authority in accordance with Article 9 and to submit evidence to the Agency that this requirement has been complied with.

Please supply the information requested in this notice in the form of a one original plus two copies within six weeks of the date of this notice. In addition please submit two copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
