County Dublin


Commencing on: **Monday 3rd March 2008 at 10.30a.m.**

- ✓ if you are intending to use equipment such as overhead projector or dvd player, in presenting your objections, you should notify the chairperson as soon as possible. In any event the onus is on the objector to arrange to have this equipment at the venue for the hearing.
