SECTION G1: COMPLIANCE WITH COUNCIL DIRECTIVES

The programme of improvements in respect of the Waste Water Works are outlined in Attachment B10 (Capital Investment Programme) of this Application. All such improvement works will be in accordance with the Dangerous Substances Directive 2006/11/EC, the Water Framework Directive 2000/60/EC, the Birds Directive 79/409/EEC, the Groundwater Directives 80/68/EEC & 2006/118/EC, the Drinking Water Directives 80/778/EEC, the Urban Waste Water Treatment Directive 91/271/EEC, the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC, the Environmental Liabilities Directive 2004/35/EC and the Bathing Water Directive 76/160/EEC where appropriate.

Reference is also made to Attachment B6 (Planning Permission & EIS) of this Application and the EIS in particular. The EIS demonstrates compliance with the Birds Directive 79/409/EEC, the Groundwater Directives 80/68/EEC & 2006/118/EC, the Drinking Water Directives 80/778/EEC, the Urban Waste Water Treatment Directive 91/271/EEC, the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC, and the Bathing Water Directive 76/160/EEC with respect to the WWTP. The Dangerous Substances Directive 2006/11/EC, the Water Framework Directive 2000/60/EC and the Environmental Liabilities Directive 2004/35/EC had not come into effect at the time the EIS was prepared.

Future Needs Assessment will consider the implications of the said Council Directives, with respect to both the existing waste water works and any required improvements.
