In accordance with Regulation 21(1) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 684 of 2007), I am to inform you of the receipt by the Agency of a number of waste water discharge licence applications from various Water Services Authorities in the Republic of Ireland.

Details of the applications received up to and including 13 February 2008, in relation to discharges which, in the view of the agency, may have potential for impact on the objectives established for a water body, situated in whole or in part in Northern Ireland, are supplied on the accompanying attachment.
