
I refer to the above referenced waste licence application and in particular to requests for an oral hearing which were considered by the Board of the Agency at its meeting of 13 November 2007.

Under the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2007 the Agency has an absolute discretion to hold an oral hearing in relation to an objection. The Board of the Agency has decided that an oral hearing of the objections will be held on a date to be decided. The Agency will notify you of the details of the hearing i.e. the date, venue and time as soon as possible.

I am to advise that, once the hearing is concluded, the Chairperson will make a written report to the Agency and include in the report a recommendation relating to the grant or refusal of a waste licence. The Agency will notify you of its decision having regard to the report of the Chairperson and the objections and the submissions made by all parties, in due course.
