re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing)
Regulations

Dear Ms Feely,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Millennium Business Park, Cappagh Road, Townland of Grange, Dublin 11. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 and Article 13 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

## **ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. The Agency notes a slight discrepancy between the applicant's name as provided in Section B.1 of the application form and the name on the company's Certification of Incorporation. The name of the applicant must be the name of the legal entity. Please clarify and amend under Section B.1 of the application form as necessary.
- 2. Complete Tables E.3(i) & E.3(ii) *Emissions to Sewer* of the Waste Licence Application Form for the proposed discharge to sewer of foul effluent arising from the activity, i.e. drainage from tipping floor, truck wash & re-fuelling area.



- 3. Provide details of the type of petrol/oil interceptors proposed for the storm water & foul effluent drainage networks at the facility. The details should include the interceptor standard, class, retention capacity and achievable oil concentration limits.
- 4. Clarify whether there are any proposals for use of the existing water abstraction well on-site.
- 5. Identify the ultimate receiving waters for uncontaminated surface water run-off from the site. Provide information on the status of the receiving waters, including the presence of any designated habitats.
- 6. Submit the appropriate fee for the waste licence application in accordance with Article 40 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004. The Agency notes that you have provided a fee of €10,000. Note that two fees are required if waste disposal and recovery are to occur.

## ARTICLE 13 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Provide an assessment of the impact of the proposed discharge of foul effluent to sewer from the facility.
- 2. Provide an update on the status of the planning application (Ref. 07A/1472) for the proposed development. Outline and assess the impact of any changes to the proposal following the Planning Authority's request for further information.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (Application Form and EIS) which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.



Please supply the information in the form of a one signed original, two hard copies and two copies in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM within <u>6 weeks</u> of the date of this notice. In addition submit sixteen copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
