I refer to your letter dated 27th February 2008 in relation to the receipt of significant further information, including revised plans and an EIS, relating to the above referenced planning application regarding the amalgamation of the two units within Block L (with an overall height of 16.5 metres) and their change of use from industrial/ warehousing use to a Materials Recovery Facility. The development will facilitate the processing of up to 95,000 tonnes per annum of C & D waste and C & I waste.

Please be advised that a Waste Licence application, including an EIS, for the proposed development to facilitate a materials recovery facility processing up to 300,000 tonnes per annum was received by the EPA, 21st December 2007. The application was submitted by MCR Personnel Limited trading as MCR Environmental and has been assigned register number W0243-01. The application and associated correspondence may be viewed on the EPA's website at www.epa.ie/Licensing/IPPCLicensing.

I am to advise you that the EPA does not propose to make any submission or observation to the Planning Authority with regard to the planning application at this time. The EPA will take into account any environmental considerations, including an assessment of the Environmental Impact Statements, as part of the Waste licensing process and a Proposed Decision and inspector's report will issue in due course.
