In accordance section 226 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Cork County Council, County Hall, Cork proposes to seek approval from An Bord Pleanála for the construction of a Wastewater Treatment Plant at Shanbally, Co. Cork, as part of the development of Cork Lower Harbour Sewerage Scheme. Cork Lower Harbour Sewerage Scheme includes upgrading of the existing waste water collection systems in the Lower Harbour area and includes construction of a new marine pipeline crossing.

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) has been prepared in respect of the proposed development.
