I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Millennium Business Park, Cappagh Road, Townland of Grange, Dublin 11. In a notice issued on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2008 under Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, the Agency asked you to submit certain additional information, which is required for compliance with the Regulations. One of the items requested under that notice was the submission of the appropriate fee for the waste licence application, in accordance with Article 40 of the Regulations.
