The existing facility consists of a transfer station and arrecycling centre. The infrastructure on-site is all directly or indirectly related to these activities and includes the following existing facilities: materials recovery facility, mechanical separation plant, glass processing facility, transfer station, two compactors, balers, timber shredding area, c&d waste processing plant, garages, storage areas, wwtp, bunded fuel storage, truck wash station, offices and a canteen.


