Re: Request for further information, in accordance with Section 94(4) of the Environmental Protection Agency Acts, 1992 to 2007, in relation to the request to transfer IPPC Licence P0412-01, in respect of a pig rearing facility at Gortnamuc, Kilcormac, Co. Offaly.

Dear Mr. Fryday,

I refer to your application for the transfer of IPPC licence Reg. No. P0412-01, received by the Agency on 26th March 2008. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the following additional information is required in support of your transfer application, under the provisions of Section 94(4) of the Environmental Protection Agency Acts, 1992 to 2007

Provide a statement that the transferee has assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, subject to agreements under the conditions of the licence, i.e. agreements between the EPA and the licensee.

Until such time as the transfer is completed, the activity is operating without a licence and is therefore not in compliance with the EPA Acts 1992 to 2007.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required information (1 signed original, 2 hard copies and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay.
