11.4 Waste Recovery Reports

The licensee shall, as part of the Annual Environmental Report for the site, submit a report on the contribution by this facility to the

achievement of the waste recovery objectives stated in condition 2.2.2.2, and as otherwise may be stated in National and European Union waste policies, and shall, as a minimum, include the following:

- (i) the recovery of construction and demolition waste*
- (ii) the recovery of other waste in landfill operations and restoration*
- (iii) the recovery of energy through landfill gas combustion.*

The Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Donegal County Council for its facility at Ballynacarrick, Ballintra, Co Donegal, Register of Licence No. W0024-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
