With regards to your waste facility, Mr. Binman, I refer to the waste application for the proposed increase in waste acceptance from 87,500 tonnes per annum to 200,000 tonnes per annum (including domestic, commercial and C&D waste streams). It is the Agency's view that an Environmental Impact Statement should accompany your waste licence application for this intensification of activities.
