

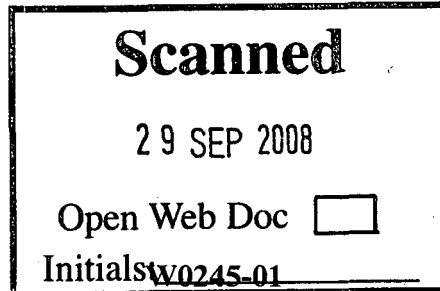

re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Ms Doyle

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Molaisin Compost Limited, Kilmolash, Cappoquin, Co Waterford. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- ⇒ On page 2 of Attachment No 2 you mention that you are **going** to take in separated household and **catering waste**. It was my understanding from my site visit on 9th September 2008, that your company were **not** going to apply to the Department of Agriculture and Food for an Animal By-Products licence. Please clarify?
- ⇒ Energy use-provide information on the amount and source of water usage at the facility. Also, mention is made in attachment G1 that the annual electricity usage is 2100 KVA. I presume this should read KW?
- ⇒ Storm water management on site. Please provide details
- ⇒ Provide a timetable regarding the proposed extension of the facility, proposed start and completion dates.

⇒ Reference is made on Attachment F3 that surface water samples will be taken upstream from the facility. However, there is only one monitoring point for surface water monitoring as per Drawing No. MCL004A. Please clarify.

⇒ Reference is made of three (3) concrete tanks in drawing No. MCL009. Are these storage tanks for firewater retention?

⇒ Emissions to sewer-do you have any plans to provide for a septic tank for the facility?

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Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within **two weeks** of the date of this notice. In addition please submit two (2) copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
