Approval Sought:

The approval of the Minister of State is sought for the grant of Licence under Section 3 of the Foreshore Act 1933 to Cork County Council, County Hall, Cork to carry out the above-mentioned proposed work in accordance with Drawings submitted:-*Drawing No. 2005-00407-Sk022 Rev C and 2005-004-07-Sk 014 Rev B

Consideration of the Application:

The application for the above-mentioned works was considered and cleared by the Department's Engineering Division, Sea Food Control Division, the members of the Marine Licence Vetting Committee, by the Marine Survey Office of the Department of Transport and by the Heritage and Planning Division of the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, Subject to conditions. Section 8, of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 applies.

Specific Conditions:

A copy of the Specific Conditions for Licence (if granted) are attached. Cork County Council has agreed the Conditions.

Rental Valuation:

The Standard charge applicable to this development is either an Annual Charge of €1,475 or a once-off payment of €21,387 on a 35 year Licence. The applicant has agreed to a once-off payment of €21,387.

Public Notice:

Details of the application were published in "The Irish Examiner" newspaper on the 10th October 2006 and details/description of the work to be carried out and a location map were available for inspection in Cobh Garda Station for 21 days after the Notice publication date. No objections were received.

Basis for the Recommendation:

This development will facilitate the disposal of treated effluent and surface water from the proposed North Cobh Sewerage System. The foul sewer outfall will be made redundant by the implementation of the Cork Lower Harbour Sewerage Scheme.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. The Licensee:

(i) shall use that part of the foreshore, the subject matter of this Licence, for the purpose of construction of an outfall pipe and diffuser, to serve foul sewers that are to be constructed as part of the North Cobh Sewers Serviced Land Initiative (hereinafter referred to as the works), in accordance with the plans and location drawings*, as submitted to, and approved by, the Minister for Communications Marine and Natural Resources (hereinafter called the Minister) and for no other purpose whatsoever;

* Drawing No. 2005-004-07-sk022 Rev D and 2005-004-07-Sketch 014 Rev D

(ii) may also use adjacent foreshore but only to the extent necessary for the purpose of constructing and maintaining the said works and shall restore the said foreshore to its proper condition immediately after such use.

2. The Licensee shall, prior to commencement of works:

- (i) provide certification by a Chartered Engineer stating that the works have been designed in accordance with relevant Irish or British Standard Specifications or Codes of Practice for strength, stability and durability, taking into account current building regulations and safety legislation;
- (ii) provide for the approval of the Minister, a detailed Construction and Method Statement for all pipe laying and construction operations on the foreshore and for the disposal of excavated material;
- (iii) give the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources 14 days notice;
- (iv) ensure that the contractor's arrangements for the control of pollutants are notified to and agreed by, both the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources and the South Western Fisheries Board;
- apply to the Commissioners of Irish Lights for sanction of new navigational aids/buoyage and/or alteration of existing navigational aids/buoyage;
- (vi) notify the British Admiralty Hydrographic Office, of the location, nature and timing of the works;
- (vii) arrange for the publication of a local marine notice. This local marine notice should give a general description of operations and approximate dates of commencement and completion. A notice in a locally read newspaper at least two weeks prior operations will suffice.

- 3. The Licensee shall, during the construction phase:
 - (i) ensure that floating plant or machinery used in connection with the works is adequately lit if in place at night or during times of poor visibility;
 - (ii) ensure that all vessels engaged in the works comply fully with the relevant certification requirements;
 - (iii) ensure that the diffuser is suitably marked to identify its location thus reducing the risk of damage from a vessel's anchor;
 - (iv) ensure that work is carried out in an environmentally friendly manner so as to minimise the impact on the foreshore and the surrounding environs;
 - (v) ensure that appropriate methods of operation are adopted in order to ensure that no spillages of fuel, hydrocarbons, cement or other leakages occur to the marine environment;
 - (vi) ensure that the site is secured form public access or encroachment by means of suitable barriers and signage;
 - (vii) comply with all lawful instructions given by the Heritage and Planning Division of the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in relation to work on the foreshore area the subject of this Lease or the surrounding area.
 - (viii) ensure that the Heritage and Planning Division is immediately informed should material of an archaeological nature be discovered, and comply with all additional conditions the Heritage and Planning Division may lawfully impose;
 - on finding any material of an archaeological nature in the foreshore area the subject of this Licence or in the surrounding area, cease all works in those areas until the Heritage and Planning Division agrees that works may be resumed, and shall comply with any conditions specified by the Heritage and Planning Division in relation thereto.
- 4. The Licensee shall ensure, that in the event of any spillage or accident occurring below the high water mark of ordinary or medium tides, or above the high water mark, which may impact on the foreshore during the carrying out of the works the subject of this Licence, or during operations following the completion of the works, the Irish Coast Guard is notified immediately by telephone.
- 5. The Licensee shall, on completion of the works:
 - (i) within two months, provide certification by a Chartered Engineer that the works have been completed in accordance with the plans/drawings approved of by the Minister and with the said Specifications or Codes of Practice;
 - (ii) make good, to the satisfaction of the Minister, any damage caused to the foreshore:
 - (iii) provide detailed location coordinates for the completed works;

- (iv) ensure that no material or debris remains at the site.
- 6. The Licensee shall ensure that the effluent treatment standard shall not exceed 25mg/l BOD and 35mg/l suspended solids. The ultimate discharge loading shall not exceed 70kgs/day BOD.
- 7. On the commissioning of the Cobh Main Drainage Scheme this Licence will expire and the Licensee shall ensure that the sewer on the foreshore is removed immediately at that stage and the foreshore reinstated.
