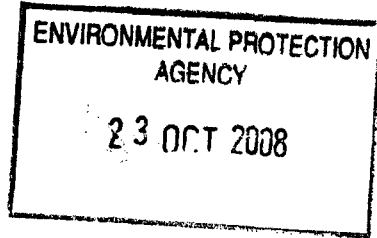

Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 17th inst. and must state how disgusted and dismayed I am at the contents of same. I and the other residents were expecting and were informed by your office that a decision would be granted in October and when your letter arrived this is what I expected it to contain.

I would remind you that a CPO notice was served on us in June, 2006. Since that time we have been living in Limbo and in these times of recession it is nothing short of a disgrace that this oral hearing is being opened up again. What is it costing? Why have you not dealt with all outstanding issues by now – surely you have had ample time? Are you just procrastinating and playing games with our lives in order to justify your own existence down in Johnstown?

I have heard several rumours lately in the locality stating that this project is not going ahead because of false information maps etc. which had been submitted to you by Fingal County Council. In fact I was informed by one individual that the report of Dr. Murnane had to be set aside because of this fact? Is there any truth in this rumour? It is not fair to be treating people in this fashion. We are facing eviction from our homes, we don't know from day to day when this decision is going to be delivered. We can make no plans for the future and the delay is only causing frustration and is damaging our health. We are given absolutely no information and have to rely on local gossip. It is simply not good enough to be treated like this. We are decent tax paying people going about our daily lives yet we have to live with this abomination which is facing us and nobody in officialdom cares - just keep wasting the taxpayers money and delaying the process even further. I notice the reason for the delay is a 1979 groundwater directive. Surely you should have been aware of this and should have dealt with it long before now.!

Please let me have a reply to this letter and let me know within what timeframe a decision will be granted.
