
Dear Mr. Howell

I am to notify you in accordance with the provisions of Article 33 (1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, that it will not be possible to carry out the procedures for the consideration of the objections within the period specified in the Regulations due to the fact that the Agency issued a notice to you on the 17th October 2008, requesting further information relating to a quantitative risk assessment. As advised by letter of 17th October 2008, the oral hearing will be re-opened to give consideration to the further information and submissions.

Having regard to the above, I am to advise that the Agency intends to complete the consideration of the objections before 26th February 2009.

The Agency intends to issue its decision on the application before the specified date, and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no avoidable delays in making its decision.
