The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use that the Agency approve the Recommended Decision to grant a Waste licence. The following documentation was submitted: recommended decision; four Third Party submissions; and summary report of the Inspector. The Directors noted that this is a review of an existing Waste Licence, Register of Licence No. W0140-02, issued by the Agency on 1 April 2005.

Recommended Decision

Introduction

Amend last sentence of 3rd paragraph to read: ...installation of a constructed wetland *stormwater* treatment system.

Condition

1.3 Amend last sentence to read: *Subject to agreement with the Agency, the licensee shall...*

1.5.2 Amend to read: Waste *shall* be accepted at the Civic Amenity Site

2.2.2.2 Amend to read: ...the use of cleaner technology, *and the prevention, reduction and minimisation of waste for disposal. The schedule shall include time frames for the achievement of set targets and shall address a five year period as a minimum. In relation to waste recovery, the schedule shall include an initial waste recovery target of waste throughput, as well as time frames for achieving higher recovery targets. As a minimum, this schedule shall include specific objectives....*

6.13.3 Add new condition as follows:
The licensee shall, as part of the AER for report year 2009, submit to the Agency the results of an independent odour assessment for the site and environs. The detail and scope of

work to be included in this assessment is to be agreed with the Agency in advance. Any recommendations arising out of this assessment will be implemented in a timeframe to be agreed with the Agency. This assessment is to be repeated thereafter as may be directed by the Agency

Amend to read:

The licensee shall, as part of the Annual Environmental Report for the site, submit a report on the contribution by this facility to the achievement of the waste recovery objectives stated in Condition 2.2.2.2 and as otherwise may be stated in National and European Union waste policies and shall, as a minimum, include tonnages of the following:

- (i) the recovery of metals;*
- (ii) the recovery of C & D derived waste materials;*
- (iii) the recovery/treatment of biowaste*
- (iv) the separation and recovery of other recyclable materials.*

Schedule

A1 Amend heading in third column to read: *Following written agreement from the Agency as per Condition 1.3*

E Add: *Odour Assessment – as required*

The Directors approved the recommended determination to grant a licence, as modified, to Nurendale Limited, trading as Panda Waste Services, for their facility at Rathdrinagh, Beaupark, Navan, Co. Meath, Register of Licence No: W0140-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
