The Agency will have regard to any submission made in accordance with the Regulations and will write, in due course, to each person who makes such a submission, to advise them of the Agency's proposed decision on the review.

In accordance with Article 22(1)(b) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004, the Agency will write to you to inform you of its proposed decision on the review in due course.
