Clean (Irl) Refuse & Recycling Ltd., Cree, Co. Clare are applying to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Waste Licence in respect of their Waste Transfer Station located at Ballinagun West, Cree, Co. Clare. An Environmental Impact Statement accompanies the waste licence application. The National Grid Reference of the site is 102728N, 165969E.

The proposed site is a waste transfer station with the type of plant in use including mechanical waste separation equipment, baling equipment and mobile plant with grab attachments. The nature of the waste is that of domestic household waste, commercial waste (non-hazardous), construction and demolition and End of Life Vehicles.
