Dear Ms. King

I refer to your correspondence dated 17/7/00 in relation to your trade effluent discharge to a Shannon Development sewer. It is noted that proposed variations are to be made to:

1. the maximum daily volume to be emitted (to be increased from 150 m<sup>3</sup>/day to 250 m<sup>3</sup>/day); and
2. the limit values for the following parameters (to be increased): pH, COD, ammonia, phosphorous, BOD, sulphates, phenols, nitrates, silver, aluminium, cobalt, chromium III, chromium VI, copper, mercury, iron, nickel, tin, zinc, arsenic, chlorides, organohalogens and colour.

The Agency has made the following decision in relation to the proposed variations:

1. There is no scope for varying the maximum daily volume to be emitted. Hence the emission limits of a maximum of 150 m<sup>3</sup>/day and 20 m<sup>3</sup>/hour remain unchanged. This condition of the licence may only be altered by way of a review of the waste licence.
2. The proposed emission limit values are agreed in accordance with Note 1 of Table G.2 which permits emission limit values to be altered with the agreement of the Agency.
